This article describes the background to NZCER's new literacy assessment, PAT: Punctuation and Grammar. There are seven PAT: punctuation and grammar tests, aimed at Year 4 to Year 10 students. The tests assess student ability to recognise and use the grammatical conventions of standard New Zealand English, including punctuation. The article describes a contextual approach to teaching and assessing grammar and punctuation, with a focus on grammar in use.
