

Features of the Larger Animal Groups



has fins	live on both land and water	has feathers
young feed on milk	has antennae	can breathe through skin
has 6 legs	warm blooded	has 3 body parts
lays eggs	has scales	has 2 stages: larval and adult
has a beak	has gills	has fur/hair
young born alive	has wings	has teeth
lays eggs	warm blooded	lays eggs
