

## Sentences II

This task is about identifying different types of sentences.

Sentence type	What it does
Declarative = <b>Statement</b>	Makes a comment or states a fact.
Interrogative = <b>Question</b>	Asks a question.
Imperative = <b>Command</b>	Makes a request or gives a command.
Exclamatory = <b>Exclamation</b>	Expresses an emotion strongly.

In the box below are examples of different sentence types.

Select the type of sentence it is by using the information provided in the chart above.

Examples	Sentence type
i) I just hate him!	<i>Statement/ Question/ Command/ Exclamation</i>
ii) His birthday is on Friday.	<i>Statement/ Question/ Command/ Exclamation</i>
iii) Why are we doing this?	<i>Statement/ Question/ Command/ Exclamation</i>
iv) Stop now!	<i>Statement/ Question/ Command/ Exclamation</i>
v) That band is awesome!	<i>Statement/ Question/ Command/ Exclamation</i>
vi) Pass the salt, please.	<i>Statement/ Question/ Command/ Exclamation</i>
