Terms		Definitions of parts of speech
a)	conjunction article noun participle verb preposition adverb pronoun adjective	Names a person, place, or object (e.g., Hakopa, Whangārei, ruler).
b)	conjunction article noun participle verb preposition adverb pronoun adjective	Stands in for a noun (e.g., she, him, them).
c)	conjunction article noun participle verb preposition adverb pronoun adjective	Describes a noun (e.g., slim, old).
d)	conjunction article noun participle verb preposition adverb pronoun adjective	Names some kind of action or being (e.g., walked, jumped, was).
e)	conjunction article noun participle verb preposition adverb pronoun adjective	Gives more information about a verb or adjective (e.g., quickly, yesterday).
f)	conjunction article noun participle verb preposition adverb pronoun adjective	Shows the relationship of one thing to another (e.g., on, under).
g)	conjunction article noun participle verb preposition adverb pronoun adjective	Connects clauses or sentences (e.g., and, when).
