**This task is about knowing the definitions for different parts of speech.**

The chart below has definitions of some parts of speech.

Match each term with the correct definition. There will be two terms that are not used.

Terms		Definitions of parts of speech
a)	<i>conjunction / article / noun / participle / verb / preposition / adverb / pronoun / adjective</i>	Names a person, place, or object (e.g., Hakopa, Whangārei, ruler).
b)	<i>conjunction / article / noun / participle / verb / preposition / adverb / pronoun / adjective</i>	Stands in for a noun (e.g., she, him, them).
c)	<i>conjunction / article / noun / participle / verb / preposition / adverb / pronoun / adjective</i>	Describes a noun (e.g., slim, old).
d)	<i>conjunction / article / noun / participle / verb / preposition / adverb / pronoun / adjective</i>	Names some kind of action or being (e.g., walked, jumped, was).
e)	<i>conjunction / article / noun / participle / verb / preposition / adverb / pronoun / adjective</i>	Gives more information about a verb or adjective (e.g., quickly, yesterday).
f)	<i>conjunction / article / noun / participle / verb / preposition / adverb / pronoun / adjective</i>	Shows the relationship of one thing to another (e.g., on, under).
g)	<i>conjunction / article / noun / participle / verb / preposition / adverb / pronoun / adjective</i>	Connects clauses or sentences (e.g., and, when).
