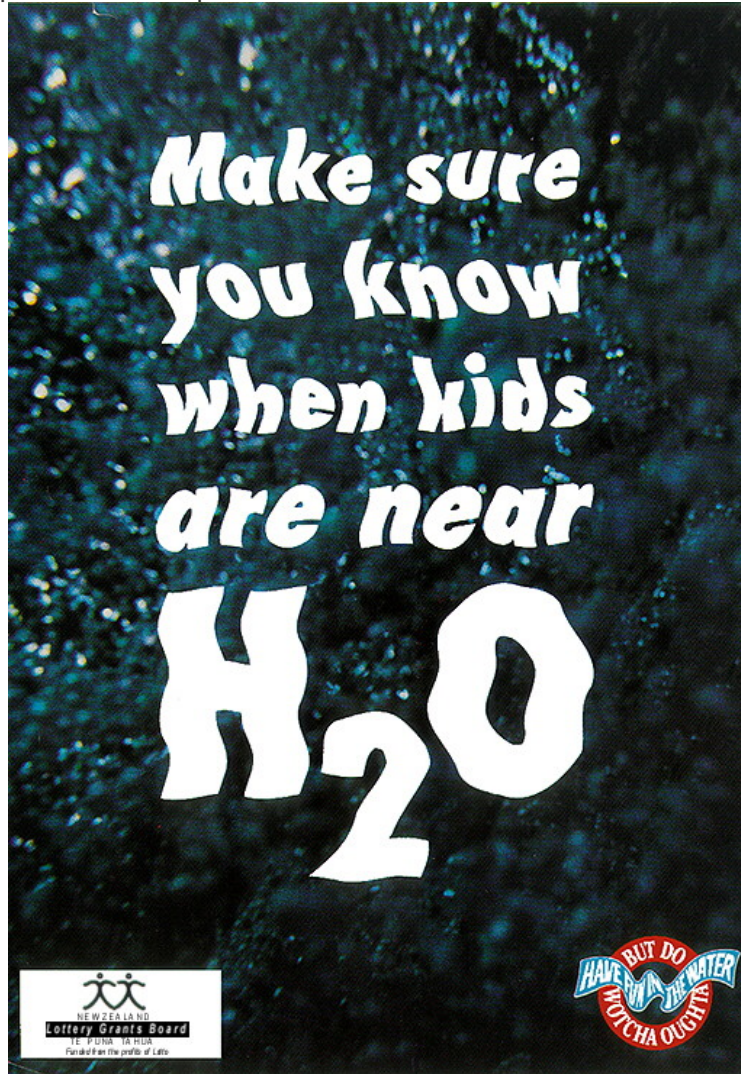


Water safety
