## **Making chapattis**

a) In <b>Picture 3</b> lines have been drawn near the boy's hands. What do these lines show?
b) In <b>Picture 5</b> arrows have been drawn next to the dough. What do these arrows show?
c) Why does the boy have his fingers crossed in <b>Picture 7</b> ?
d) In <b>Picture 7</b> an arrow has been drawn next to the chapatti. What does the arrow show?
e) What is something about <b>Picture 8</b> that shows the boy is looking forward to eating the chapattis?

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
