

Making chapattis

This task is about understanding how words and images can be used to write a recipe.

A chapatti is a flat, thin bread. Read the instructions on how to make chapattis in the article "Chapattis" pages 13-15 in School Journal, Part 1, No 2, 1998, and look at the pictures to help you answer the questions.

. In **Picture 3** lines have been drawn near the boy's hands. What do these lines show?

. In **Picture 5** arrows have been drawn next to the dough. What do these arrows show?

. Why does the boy have his fingers crossed in **Picture 7**?

. Colour in the parts in **Picture 7** which show that the pan is hot.

. In **Picture 7** an arrow has been drawn next to the chapatti. What does the arrow show?

. What is something about **Picture 8** that shows the boy is looking forward to eating the chapattis?
