

Trampoline bounce

This task is about looking at the visual and written features of a poem.

Read the poem **Trampoline Bounce**, page 32 of **Junior Journal 17, 1997**, and look at the pictures to help answer the questions.

- . What do the lines around the pictures of the children show?

The mother is the person depicted at the bottom right-hand corner of the page.

- . **Draw arrows** pointing at **three** parts of the image of the mother which show that she feels worried.
- . Why is the mother most likely worried?

- . **Draw a circle** around the words in the poem which go best with the picture of the mother.
- . Look at the way the letters in the title of the poem have been written. How do they fit with the idea of a trampoline?

- . How many children are using the trampoline?
