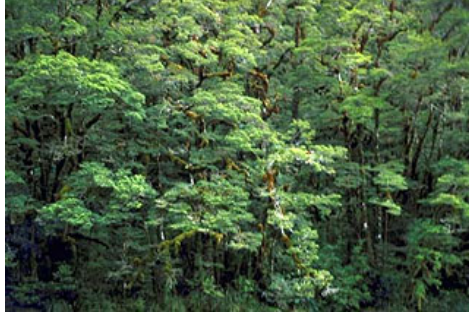


The beech forest III
