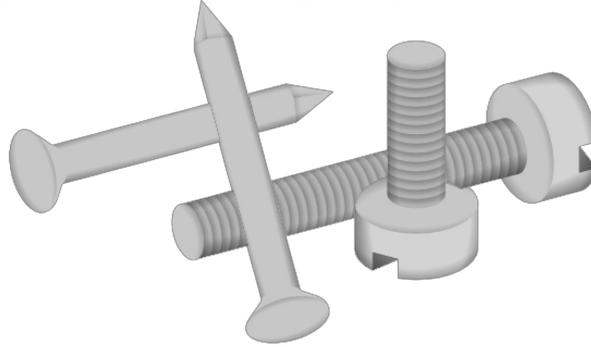


Estimating bags and boxes
