

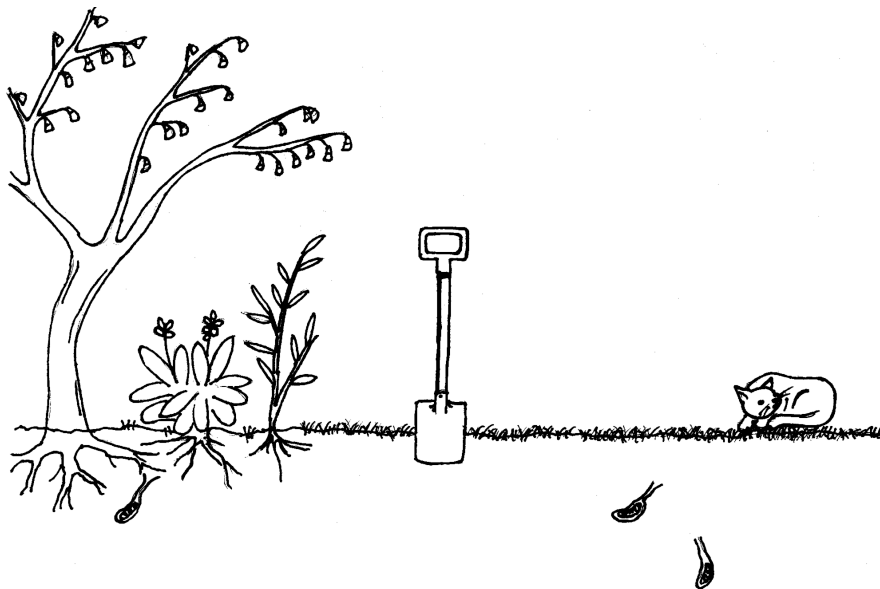
# What's in the garden?

b) A relationship is a connection between 2 things. An example of a relationship in the picture could be:


Grass grubs eat the roots of the grass plants.
