This task is about putting data into a table and explaining what the data means.

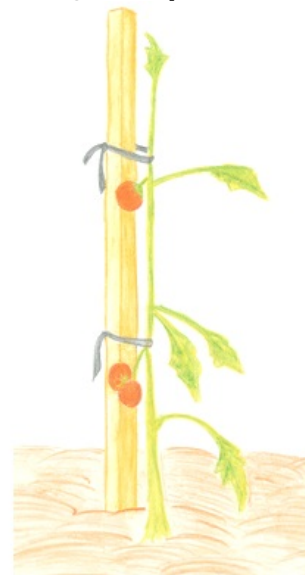
Ally and Jack each grew a tomato plant at school. They wanted to see who could grow the healthier plant.
